# **COCO CARES**

Our goal is to preserve the environment so that everyone can enjoy its beauty for years to come. We are always seeking out opportunities to improve our resort and to minimise our impact on the ecosystem. For example:

#### Plastic

- We have banned single-use plastic water bottles from our resort.
- We use paper straws instead of plastic ones.
- We produce our own drinkable water, reducing the need to purchase bottled water.
- We purchase soft drinks packaged in recyclable materials like aluminium and glass instead of plastic.
- We have implemented a single-use plastic bag ban across the whole island.
- We use biodegradable takeaway boxes, plates, and cups for all excursions.

#### Recycling

- We use recycled paper and try to limit its use on the island.
- We use recycled wood for outdoor furniture like tables, chairs, and benches.
- We operate an on-site natural sewage water treatment plant.
- Food refuse is collected and disposed of separately.
- Combustible rubbish is incinerated, cans are compacted, and glass is reused where possible, or crushed.

#### Awareness

- A weekly information session about sea turtles is conducted by the Veterinarian from the Olive Ridley Project (ORP)
- A weekly information session about marine conservation is conducted by the Marine Biologist.

#### **Energy-Saving**

- We use energy-saving lightbulbs in all public areas.
- We use rainwater for generator radiators.

#### Marine Conservation and Protection

- The Marine Biologist oversees a Coral Nursery Project to provide broken coral frames a chance to survive and to monitor their growth.
- We contribute to the MantaWatch and SharkWatch research projects in the Maldives.
- We have partnered with the Olive Ridley Project (ORP) to run a Marine Turtle Rescue Centre on our island, to rehabilitate injured sea turtles. Our Marine Biologist also contributes to the ORP's research projects.
- Sea Turtles Nest Protection Program-monitoring the Green and Hawksbill Sea Turtles nests on the resort.



#### **Sustainable Practices**

- We adopt a serious policy not to catch undersized fish to prevent overexploitation of the local fish population.
- We also adopt the same seafood purchasing policy we do not purchase any undersized species from local fishermen.
- We purchase local, handmade roofing for our villas from nearby islands.
- We plant and farm a variety of fruit trees, vegetables, and herbs on our island, and practice composting.
- We only use biodegradable chemicals for any Housekeeping operations.

We encourage you to help us in our sustainability efforts, by doing the following:

#### **Energy-Saving**

Our electricity is produced by generators on the island. To save energy, we would appreciate it if you:

- Limit the use of your air conditioner. Commune with nature by enjoying the fresh tropical breeze or use your ceiling fan.
- Keep all doors and windows closed when the air conditioner is on.
- Turn off the lights that are not in use. Please do not tamper with the light-saving device.

#### Waste

Disposal of garbage is another concern on the islands. As such, we encourage you to take your non-combustible waste with you back home where the opportunities for effective recycling exist e.g. Batteries, plastic bottles etc.

#### Water

Considering that 99% of the Maldives is sea, fresh water supply is an ongoing concern. Like all resort islands, Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu has its own water production plant.

- Be considerate of water usage in your villas.
- While the tap water in your villas is safe to use for bathing and brushing your teeth, we advise you not to drink it. Drinkable water produced in-house is available in glass bottles in your villas.
- Let your Villa Attendant know if you want to have your towels & linen changed.

# WELCOME TO OUR LIVING REEF!

The islands of the Maldives rest upon an immense structure of coral reefs, which protect low-lying islands such as ours. Beyond the reefs, the sea deepens to more than 2000 meters. We are surrounded by this living coral ecosystem that is home to a magnificent variety of reef fish, shells, starfish & many more marine creatures.

The Maldives has not remained untouched by conditions that are threatening our planet. Global warming and associated climatic changes, sea level rise and environmental pollution have had their effect on our surroundings. We are committed to creating awareness to help and preserve our marine ecosystem from pollution and destruction. Here are some ways in which you can assist us in this endeavour:

- Do not touch or remove corals, fish, or any other sea life from the water. Resist the urge to collect souvenirs photographs make wonderful trophies; dead starfish & seashells do not.
- Touching live coral may injure or kill the coral, and it may take up to ten years to grow back. Please refrain from standing on or touching our reef.
- Do not throw rubbish into the sea or on to the beach. Whether you enjoy diving, snorkelling, surfing, or just relaxing on the beach, always clean up after yourself.
- Do not collect shells from the beach or from the sea.
- Do not use gloves, knives, harpoons, or spears when snorkelling or diving.
- Do not feed the fish- they become dependent on being fed and lose their instinct to find food.
- When you leave, take items like plastic bottles, batteries, and cans back home with you where they can be recycled or disposed of properly.
- Do not fish in the lagoons- we offer fishing trips for guests in the deep ocean as part of our wide range of activities and experiences.
- Sea cucumbers that are abundant in our water are vital to the ecosystem. Please allow them to perform their daily activity undisturbed.
- Stingrays and eagle rays come into the lagoon & shallow water daily. We ask you to be careful while wading in the shallows & encourage you to do the "stingray shuffle" (shuffle feet while wading in surf) to alert these beautiful marine animals that you are there.
- Practice responsible boating, kayaking, and other recreational activities on the water. Never throw anything overboard and be aware of marine life in the waters around you.
- Sea turtles, their eggs, and nests are legally protected in the Maldives. Green and Hawksbill turtles have been known to come to our island to nest and we take great care to protect these nests until they hatch. These turtles are considered "endangered" and "critically endangered" by the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species. If you happen to be lucky enough to see these beautiful creatures nesting, kindly inform any member of our staff immediately.

Snorkelling and diving are wonderful ways to view the underwater environment and we encourage you to participate in these activities. Beyond the outer reef, the current can be strong at times. Please be careful at all times when swimming in deep water. We strongly advise you not to go snorkelling or swimming alone and encourage you to use a life vest.

# PARTNERSHIP WITH THE OLIVE RIDLEY PROJECT

The Olive Ridley Project is a UK-based charity whose mission is to remove discarded fishing nets- known as ghost nets- from the ocean; rescue and rehabilitate sea turtles injured by these nets; reuse and reduce marine debris; and educate the world about the dangers of ghost nets and the perilous situation of sea turtles. The project is named after the Olive Ridley species of sea turtle, which is by far the most frequent victim of these ghost nets.

In 2015, we announced our official partnership with the Olive Ridley Project to setup turtle rescue centres and to work together to reduce the effect of ghost nets on marine life. In February 2017 we opened the first of these veterinarian-led Marine Turtle Rescue Centres at Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu, fully equipped with a surgical unit to care for the turtles that we find around the country with severe injuries to their flippers and necks after being entangled in ghost gear.

Guests can choose to donate to the charity upon check-out at the Reception, or you can purchase handmade turtle plush toys from the Marine Biology Centre or the Reception, the sale of which goes towards supporting the charity and the rescue centre.

We encourage guests to visit the Marine Turtle Rescue Centre to see our turtle patients, and to chat with the resident Olive Ridley Project Veterinarian for more information about this important cause.





# **BEACH EROSION**

The islands of the Maldives are made up of coral reefs and are entirely dependent upon the continuous ecological and physical processes of the delicate coral reef ecosystem.

Our beaches are subject to continuous change, with the natural forces of wind and water interacting with the land.

At Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu, our beach is constantly changing as a result of the different monsoons. During the south west monsoon when the waves come from the west and south west, the sand is moved so much that often it builds up on the eastern side of the island. The reverse happens during the north east monsoon. This often contributes to the long-term erosion of the beach,

We are doing our best to reduce beach erosion. As such, we urge all our guests to not touch any living coral. Coral reefs act as our natural first line of defence against beach erosion. You will also see a wall of sandbags in various shapes to minimise and control the negative impact of the monsoon and the sea currents.

The movement of the sand can appear to be a dramatic change, especially if you are returning to our island after some time. We assure you that this is a typical, natural phenomenon in the Maldives.

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#### Adaptors

A 3-pin adaptor is provided in your villa. This is for your use should you wish to charge your mobile phone, laptops, camera, etc.

#### Air Conditioner

You will find the remote-control for the AC unit next to your bed. The AC indoor unit is located on the ceiling behind your bed, while the sensor for the remote is located close to the ceiling in front of your bed. In our efforts to reduce our impact on the environment, we encourage you to enjoy the natural breeze or use the ceiling fan whenever possible.

#### **Airport Transportation**

Arrangements for your transfer to Male' International Airport will be finalised the day before your departure. Kindly observe the designated check-out times to avoid any delays.

#### Alcohol

All alcohol is prohibited on the local islands but our bars and restaurants are well stocked with an excellent range of wines and other alcoholic beverages.

#### Amenities

A wide selection of our bathroom amenities is available at Spa Reception if you wish to purchase them. Please contact Ext. O.

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#### Baby Cots

Available upon request. Please contact Ext. 0.

#### Babysitting

We provide babysitting services for a nominal fee. We require at least 24 hours advance notice to arrange this for you. For more information, please contact Ext. 0.

#### Badminton

A Badminton Court is located behind the Coco Spa. Rackets and shuttlecocks are available at Reception.

#### Batteries

Please deposit your used batteries at Reception where a box is kept for proper disposal or better yet, take them home with you where recycling will be possible.



## Coffee & Tea

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Complimentary coffee and tea are provided in your villa. They will be replenished every day.

### Check-Out Time

Our regular check-out time is 12 noon. For more information, please contact Reception on Ext. 0.

### Coco Water

This bottle of water is produced and bottled in-house at our desalination plant. It is purified and filtrated using UV filters.

### Departure

Your host will take care of your departure arrangements and a departure letter will be sent to your villa the evening prior with information such as the check-out time, luggage pickup time, seaplane or speedboat departure time and wake-up call (if necessary).

#### Doctor

A doctor on the nearby island may be consulted for medical emergencies. Our associates can easily arrange a visit for you. Please contact Ext. 0.

## Do Not Disturb

If you wish not to be disturbed by telephone calls, you may deactivate the connection to your villa by dialling 0000. If you wish not to be disturbed in your room, place the Need Privacy sign outside of your villa.

## Dress Code

Please cover up swim wear while in the Reception or restaurants. In the evenings; trousers, button down shirts, T-shirts or polo shirts are recommended for the gentlemen, while we encourage ladies to wear a casual dress, skirt or slacks. While visiting any local islands, please be mindful of your dress code; we recommend that ladies cover their shoulders and thighs and men are advised to wear clothes covering their chests. Avoid wearing only your swim wear or transparent clothes. Nudity and topless sunbathing is strictly forbidden and a fine of US\$100 is levied in case of infringement.

#### Fishing

Our resort is dedicated to a sustainable approach towards the marine environment. Fishing is strictly prohibited off the jetty, reef, or any other areas around the resort. We do conduct excursions for deep sea fishing; however, we adhere to strict fish size limits. Should you wish to join in this activity, please contact our Lifestyle Hosts on Ext. 0 or 131.

#### Fitness Room

#### Games

#### Hammocks

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Hammocks can be found in certain areas of the island. Spend the day relaxing while you enjoy the warm sea breeze as you gently swing away.

#### House Reef Recovery Project

The house reef surrounding our island has been heavily affected by different bleaching events that occurred in the Maldives in 1998, 2010, 2011 and 2017. Spearheaded by our in-house Marine Biologist, we are conducting a project to stimulate and accelerate the growth of different coral species within our lagoon.

#### Internet / Wifi

Wifi internet is available all across the island.

#### Keys

In the event of a lost or broken key, USD 50 will be charged to your account to cover the cost of a new lock installation – this is for your safety and that of future guests. Kindly note that the door to your villa does not automatically lock when the door is closed. As such, please be mindful to always push the button on the inside doorknob to lock the door and to take your keys with you when leaving the villa.

#### Laundry

If you wish to have your laundry picked up from your room, please call Ext. 0 or simply put your dirty laundry in the laundry bag or basket, and fill out the laundry form. Your Villa Attendant will pick it up when he comes by to refresh your villa.

#### Library

Located in the Reception where you can enjoy a selection of books and magazines in many different languages.

#### Lighting

Lighting on the pathways is dim to preserve the natural feel of the island. Rechargeable emergency flashlights are provided in each villa. Please make sure that it is always recharged when they are not in use. They are not waterproof, so please be careful that they don't get wet.

#### Linen

Our linens are not bleached and are made from undyed natural cotton. To minimise water wastage and usage of cleaning products, your towels will only be changed when placed in the laundry basket. Please let you Villa Attendant know if you wish to have your bedsheets changed.

### Mail and Stamps

Stamps are available at the boutique located in the Reception. A daily mail service is provided and a mail box is located at the Reception.

#### Mini Bar

This is your personal bar. Food and beverage items will be charged to your villa account as consumed. For additional refills, please contact on Ext. 0.

#### **Mobile Phones**

To maintain the peace and tranquillity of the island, please be mindful of the volume of your mobile phone. Most of our guests come to the island to get away from their everyday life and to commune with nature – we at the resort try to do our best to help them achieve that.

### R Recreation and Water Sports

Catamaran sailing, windsurfing, water skiing and kayaking are water activities that you can enjoy whilst on the island. Lessons are available on request. Do visit our Watersports Centre located on the beach just across Cowrie Restaurant or please contact on Ext. 0.

### Safety Deposit Box

A safe is provided for your convenience. We recommend that you use the safe at Reception to keep large amounts of cash. Please note that the resort is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen property. Please ensure that you empty the safe prior to departure.

#### Scuba Diving

Maldives is one of the most beautiful diving destinations in the world. It is famous for its rich marine life. There are approximately 32 diving sites to choose from. Each site has its own appeal and its own variety of fish. Please refer to the attached Activities page.

#### Sewing Kit

#### Sightseeing

#### Smoking

Please refrain from smoking while on the bed. Ashtrays can be found all over the islandplease use them for their intended purpose. Do not stub your cigarettes on the sand or throw your cigarette butts into the water.

### Snorkelling

Enjoy snorkelling in our house reef or explore a more distant site by boat with our Excursion Guide. Snorkelling lessons can be conducted for beginners on request. Please contact Reception on Ext. O.

#### Spa

## Sunbathing

Maldives is located within the equatorial region of the Indian Ocean where the sun is very strong. Use appropriate sunblock and we advise you to reapply every 2 hours or so. Even if you are in the water or snorkelling, please do not forget to put on sun protection.

## Swimming / Snorkelling

Enjoy a swim in the warm blue waters of the lagoon. Be aware that the current can be strong at times and it is advisable that you swim close to the shore and that you refrain from swimming at night. Please note that there are no lifeguards available at the resort and swimming in the ocean is at your own risk. If you are not a strong and confident swimmer, the use of a lifejacket is advised.

#### Tennis

A flood-lit tennis court is available for your use between 19:00hrs – 23:00hrs. Tennis rackets & balls can be rented for a nominal fee. Partners can also be arranged on request. For reservations, please contact Ext. 0.

#### Time

Our island time is one hour ahead of Malé in order to enjoy an additional hour of daylight.

## W Wake-up Call

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To program your wake-up call, dial #5 followed by the time you wish to be awakened. Be mindful of using the 24-hour format when programming your wake-up call (E.g. #5 0730). Alternatively, you can call Reception at Ext. 0 to book a wake-up call

#### Water

Our tap water is desalinated seawater and it is safe to use but not to drink. Coco Water, our in-house drinkable water, is provided in all the villas in glass bottles. Water being scarce, we encourage our guests not to waste it.

Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu takes the health and safety of all guests and associates very seriously.

Please adhere to the following emergency and safety protocols to ensure a smooth and efficient response to any incidents.

## In Case of a Fire Emergency

If you witness smoke or a fire, immediately dial Ext. 0 or the national emergency number 119 and report the incident.

- Each room is fitted with a smoke detector, which connects to a central control panel.
- If the fire can be contained, use the firefighting equipment at your disposal while waiting for the fire team.
- If the fire is out of control, **EVACUATE** your villa **IMMEDIATELY**, closing all doors behind you. Do not try to take your belongings. The safe in your villa is fireproof.
- For your own safety and that of the resort, please do not smoke while in bed, and do not use multiple appliances from one single plug point.

Please see the map on your villa door for the fire evacuation plan specific to your villa number. In an emergency, immediately proceed to the designated location and follow instructions given by the emergency team.

## In Case of a Tsunami

A tsunami is a series of ocean waves that can be a threat to residents of coastal areas. It may last for several hours and may be generated by earthquakes either nearby or far away. They may come at any time with little or no warning.

Please see the map on your villa door for the tsunami evacuation plan specific to your villa number. Should there be a tsunami threat, immediately proceed to the designated location and follow instructions given by the emergency team.



## Tsunami Watch

A tsunami watch is issued when an earthquake has been detected that might generate a series of large waves.

- If the management feels a tsunami is approaching, all guests will be requested to put on warm clothes and a life vest, and proceed to the **TENNIS COURT**.
- Only return to your villa once cleared by the management to do so.
- In case of a blackout during the night due to any emergency, you have a torch light in your wardrobe to aid you.
- Whatever the case, think of your safety FIRST. Do not take risks.

### In Case of a Medical Emergency

If serious injury or illness occurs on the island, immediately dial Ext. O, the national emergency number 119, or call for help. Give your name, exact location and describe the nature and severity of the medical problem. The Resort will provide instructions until the emergency team arrives.

In case of serious injury or illness, the nearest person must quickly perform the following.

- Keep the injured/ill still and comfortable.
- Check the breathing.
- Control serious bleeding by applying direct pressure on the wound.
- Look for emergency medical I.D.'s such as bracelets on injured persons, question witnesses and give all information to the responding emergency team.
- Only qualified persons should provide first aid treatment.



## Swimming Safety Tips

The sea has an unpredictable temperament and we advise you to practice extreme caution when swimming. Currents may be strong despite appearing calm on the surface, and could be too much to handle even for strong swimmers. For your swimming safety, abide by the following guidelines:

- Always swim with a partner
- Never venture out beyond the reef into unknown areas
- Never swim in the sea at night
- Do not swim in areas where boats and sea vessels traverse
- Do not swim after consuming any amount of alcohol
- Beware of stinging creatures on the seabed, such as stonefish or stingrays.
- Do not attempt to touch them at all times.
- Watch out for sharp corals that may cut your feet, knees and hands.

Please note that there is no lifeguard on duty at our beaches.



## Snorkelling Safety Tips

Here are some tips to make your snorkelling experience safe and enjoyable.

- Adjust the masks and snorkel settings before getting in the water.
- Always snorkel with a "Buddy". Keep sight of each other while snorkelling, so if either experiences difficulty, the other can assist.
- When jumping into the sea, remember to hold the mask so that it won't slip.
- If you have to make a mask adjustment while snorkelling, swim back to the beach or villa deck after notifying your buddy. Gently put your fins down and then fix your gear. Be careful not to stand on live corals.
- If snorkelling in shallow water, be aware of the position of your knees in relation to the coral, or else you may get a coral cut.
- Stay with a group or your buddy do not drift off on your own. If you get caught in a current you can't swim against, swim across it to return to your villa or the beach.
- Do not go snorkelling at night.

Swim with a life jacket if you are not a confident swimmer. Life jackets are available at the Watersports Centre. Please note that there is no lifeguard on duty at our beaches.

For the protection of our environment please do not use any gloves or knives while snorkelling. please do not touch any of the corals or any other sea life.



## Sun Exposure Tips

It is highly necessary to have adequate protection before you venture out into the sun. Here are some tips to be followed to enjoy a warm day in the tropics.

- Do not forget to apply appropriate sun protection lotions. Use a product with a high Sun Protection Factor (SPF), at least 15-20 minutes before facing the sun. Broad-spectrum sun protection lotions protect against both UVA as well as UVB rays. Apply it generously all over the exposed areas of the body and reapply after every 2-3 hours.
- While lying under the sun, use ultraviolet protecting sunglasses on your eyes.
- We advise you not to sunbathe for more than an hour at a time.
- Drink plenty of fluids to prevent dehydration

### In Case of a Sunburn

The first signs of sunburn may not appear for a few hours. The full effect to your skin may not appear for 24 hours or even longer. In case of sunburn symptoms, please do the following.

- Try taking a cool bath or shower. Place wet, cold towels on the burn for 10 to 15 minutes, several times a day.
- Apply a soothing lotion or aloe gel to the skin. DO NOT apply petroleum jelly, butter or oil to the skin as they make the symptoms worse and prevent healing.
- A pain medication, such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen may be helpful.
- We advise you to visit the Coco Spa for further sunburn treatments, or to seek medical attention.
